

ARMS Client/Care Recipient Screens Changed

The Client and Care Recipient Screens have been modified for CNDS implementation.

A Suffix field has been added to both the Client and Care Recipient Screens for users to select any Suffix as displayed in a drop down box. If **no** suffix is used, users do not have to make a Suffix selection. An edit check has been added to the First and Last name fields where only alpha characters will be allowed in ARMS.


