General Overview of Committees

Executive Committee:

The executive committee shall be comprised of Chairs from all existing working committees and may carry out such responsibilities as requested from time to time by the general membership.

Officers shall be elected by the Council by simple majority vote. ¹

Standing Committees:

Committee chairpersons shall recruit their committee members, who may include non-Advisory council members, in consultation with the [Council] chair. One voting member of the council must serve as the chair or co-chair of each committee. Each committee shall meet as often as necessary, and with the approval of the [Council] chair, to perform its duties. Sufficient oral or written notice of the date, time and place of such meeting shall be given. ²
