Ambulatory surgery center proposed in Raeford

RALEIGH – FirstHealth of the Carolinas, Inc. and the Surgery Center of Pinehurst have filed an application with the Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to develop an ambulatory surgery center.

A public hearing for this project has been scheduled for 11 a.m. on Oct. 16 in the Hoke County Commissioners Room, Pratt Building, 227 North Main St., Raeford.

The \$4.6-million Surgery Center of Hoke proposal seeks to relocate two licensed operating rooms from Surgery Center of Pinehurst in Moore County to the medical campus of the proposed FirstHealth Hoke Community Hospital in Raeford.
