Mission Hospital proposes \$8.3-million facility renovation

RALEIGH – Mission Hospital Inc. has filed an application with the Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to renovate the fourth and sixth floors of Mission Hospital.

A public hearing for this project will be held on Nov. 16, at 2 p.m. in Classroom 1 of the Mountain Area Health Education Center (MAHEC), 501 Biltmore Ave., Asheville.

The proposed \$8.3-million project involves renovation of the west wing of the fourth floor and the west wing of the sixth floor. Four West will be renovated for a Neurosciences unit which will relocate from the sixth floor. Once the Neurosciences unit is consolidated on Four West, Mission will renovate the vacated space on the sixth floor for orthopaedic patients.
