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Autumn Care of Mocksville proposes to replace 108-bed nursing facility

RALEIGH – Autumn Care of Mocksville has filed an application with the Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to replace its 108-bed combination nursing facility.

A public hearing for this project will be held at 11 a.m. on Thurs., Dec. 17, the Davie County Public Library, 371 North Main Street, in Mocksville.

The \$9.6 million project will result in the replacement and relocation of the current 108-bed combination nursing facility that includes 96 nursing home beds and 12 adult care home beds. The current facility is located on Howard Street in Mocksville. The proposed location for the new facility is near the southwest corner of I-40/US-601 (Yadkinville Rd) interchange in Mocksville. The proposed facility will incorporate a neighborhood design concept, including smaller nursing units and resident-centered dining, which will result in a more home-like environment for residents.
