CMC-Mercy seeks to add 38 acute care beds

RALEIGH – Mercy Hospital, Inc. d/b/a Carolinas Medical Center-Mercy (CMC-Mercy) has filed an application with the Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to add 38 acute care beds.

A public hearing for this project will be held at 10 a.m. on Dec. 14 in Room 278 at the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Government Center, 600 East 4th St., Charlotte.

The application is in response to a need determination in the 2011 State Medical Facilities Plan for 107 acute care beds in Mecklenburg County. If approved, the proposed project is scheduled to be completed in November 2013 at an estimated cost of \$6.7 million.
