**Presbyterian Orthopaedic Hospital seeks to add
50 acute care beds and develop a replacement hospital**

RALEIGH – The Presbyterian Orthopaedic Hospital has filed an application with the Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to add 50 acute care beds in a replacement facility located at the intersection of Caswell Road and Fifth Street in Charlotte, across the street from the existing facility.

A public hearing for this project will be held at 10 a.m. on Dec. 14 in the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Government Center, 2nd Floor, Room 278, 600 East 4th St., Charlotte.

The 2011 State Medical Facilities Plan (SMFP) identifies a need for 107 additional acute care beds in Mecklenburg County. The proposed replacement hospital will have 64 acute care beds, 16 skilled nursing beds, 12 non-licensed observation beds, 10 surgical operating rooms, diagnostic radiology, and other ancillary and support services.

The projected capital cost to develop the replacement hospital is \$84,107,759, and the project is scheduled for completion in October 2015.
