J. Arthur Doshier Memorial Hospital proposes renovation

RALEIGH – J. Arthur Doshier Memorial Hospital has filed an application with the Certificate of Need Section of the N.C. Division of Health Service Regulation to renovate and expand the hospital.

A public hearing for this project will be held on Jan. 20 at 1 p.m. in Southport City Hall, City Council Chambers, Southport.

The project is expected to cost \$11 million. The hospital proposes to replace semi-private rooms with private rooms, renovate 15,196 existing square feet and add 6,099 square feet. The project is expected to be complete Oct. 1, 2013.
