Minimum Standards the Company the Program Uses to Complete the Criminal Background Check Must Meet

- The company an adult day services program chooses to complete a criminal background check must be one approved by the Administrative Offices of the Courts.
- The North Carolina Administrative Offices of the Courts maintains a list of approved companies on its web site at: <u>http://www.nccourts.org/</u>

1. Once at the North Carolina Court System web page, click on the drop down menu at the top of the page titled, "QUICK SITE INDEX: " Select a topic..

2. Scroll down to the B section of the drop down menu and click on "Background Checks, Criminal"

- 3. This will take you to the "Criminal Background Checks" page
- 4. Scroll to the bottom of the page and click on <u>Click for a list</u>
- 5. This will open the list of approved agencies

****NOTE**** This list is subject to change. Best Practice would be to review the list before ordering a criminal background check to ensure that the agency is one approved by the North Carolina Administrative Offices of the Courts.

Geographical Requirements of the Criminal Background Check

• The criminal background check must be statewide.

****NOTE**** A county wide criminal background check does not meet the minimum Standards for Certification and if is submitted, will have to be re-done and re-submitted.

Timeframe Requirements of the Criminal Background Check

• The criminal background check must be for the past five years.

****NOTE**** A criminal background check that was conducted for less than 5 years does not meet the minimum Standards for Certification. If this is submitted, the program will be required to re-do the criminal background check.
