**Kindergarten Health Assessment Compliance Report**  
**2009-2010 School Year**

The Kindergarten Health Assessment (KHA) is a required component of school entry in North Carolina since 1985 (N.C. General Statute 130A-440). The North Carolina Certificate of Immunization and the Kindergarten Health Assessment together provide assurance that the children of North Carolina have been seen by a health care provider and are “ready to learn”.

The KHA process assesses the health and developmental status of the child entering public kindergarten and serves several purposes:

- For the health care provider, the KHA provides a structure by which the child is assessed and documents health and developmental parameters and milestones.
- For the parent or guardian, the KHA is a form that can be duplicated and saved as a health history.
- For the school health program, the KHA serves as a communication tool for developing an emergency action plan and/or an individual health plan.
- For the community, the KHA provides data that can be anonymously aggregated and describes the health status of kindergarten children statewide.

The information requested on the form has been reviewed by early childhood education specialists, school health specialists, pediatricians, school nurses, school officials and public health leaders for its relevance and importance to the child’s educational achievement.

Completion of the KHA Status Report by individual schools is a required annual report. Each year, it is submitted to the Division of Public Health no later than 60 days after the start of the school year.

This school year, 95% of kindergarten students had a KHA document on file or were exempt on the basis of religious beliefs.
