No Texting While Driving Law Becomes Effective December 1, 2009

North Carolina prohibits **all** drivers from texting or reading a text message while a vehicle is in motion.

A driver that is caught texting or reading a text message while driving will face a fine of \$100 plus court fees of at least \$130.00. The violation will not add points to your driving record however and an insurance surcharge will not be assessed.

Exceptions include: those performing in official duties such as: a law enforcement officer; a member of a fire department; or the operator of a public or private ambulance.
