- CSBG Current & Future
 - 2.9% reduction in CSBG FY 2011 budget...
 - FY 2012 funding pending – Discussions to fund CSBG at a 50% reduction are ongoing
 - Competitive Funding Model???
 - What can you do? What is OEO doing?
- Multi County Designation
 - Targeted for completion by June 30, 2011. Date is tentative.
- Transitions
 - DHHS *Excels*
 - OEO & the Department of Social Services
- Agency Monitoring Plan
 - The Application
 - Establishes the roadmap for annual utilization of funding to meet the community's identified, documented and unique needs for service provision to low-income persons
 - New items for FY 2012
 - County Commissioner Review – 10A NCAC 97C .0111(b)(1)(A) states that agency must submit its application to each county commissioner board for which it is designated. The commissioners should have 30 days to comment on the application.
 - Public Hearings – 10A NCAC 97C .0111(b)(1)(B) requires that a hearing is held in each county served.
 - Child Support Services and Referrals – Sec 678 G – inform custodial parents in single-parent families about the availability of child support and referral eligible parents to child support offices.
 - Service Denial Appeals – 10A NCAC 97B .0502 requires participants to receive written notification of appeals process notification in writing (within 10 days) of the reasons for denial, within 7 days upon request hold a hearing for appeal, within 7 days after the hearing notify the appellant of the final decision.
 - Desktop Review
 - Reports, AR4CA, Tripartite Board Profiles, Board Minutes, Budget Changes, etc.
 - Risk Assessment
 - Completed annually providing an opportunity for the OEO to review information and plan training, technical assistance and/or monitoring to assist the agency
 - Comprehensive Onsite Monitoring (*Whole Health Monitoring*)
 - The CSBG Act **requires** that the state monitor grantees at least every three years. OEO's plan is to execute a plan of every two years. **High Risk** agencies and/or agencies with open/previous monitoring findings which require follow-up are visited as needed.
