



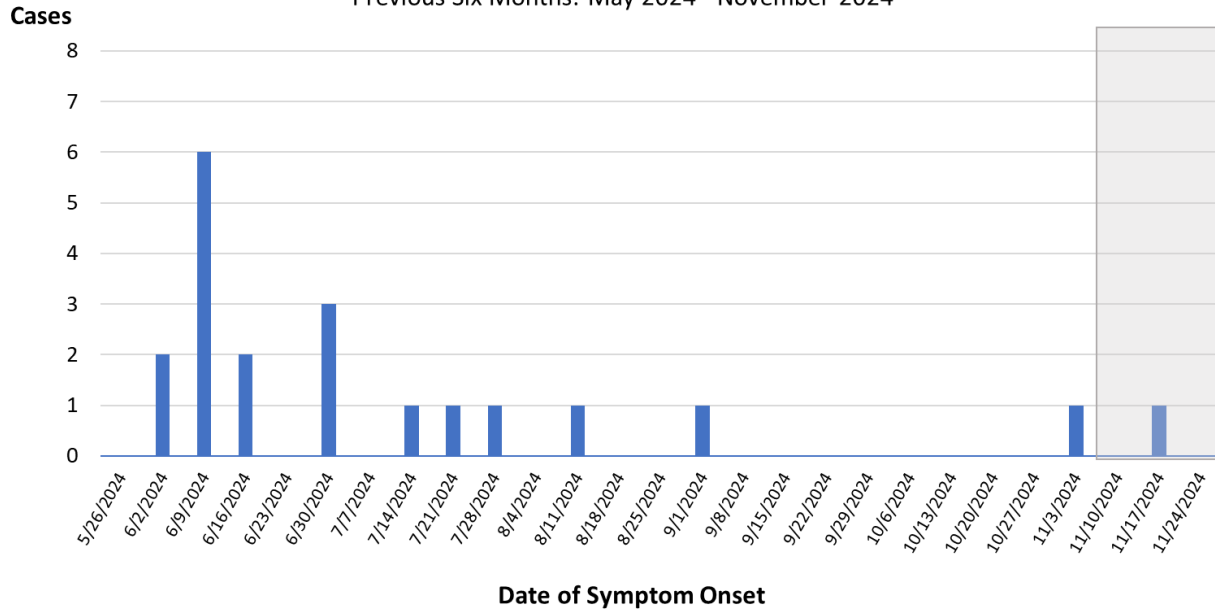

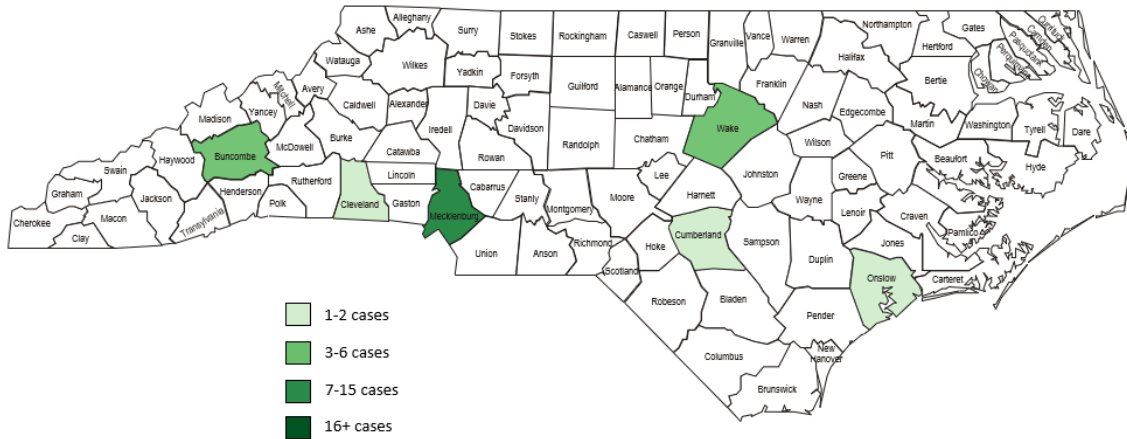


Figure 1: Mpox Cases by County, Previous Six Months: May 2024 – November 2024
