You MUST have established residency in NC Documentation regarding I/DD or TBI diagnosis is REQUIRED (i.e., psychological) Individuals diagnosed with a brain injury by the age of 21 may be eligible for I/DD services NC has a Registry of Unmet Needs for the <u>Innovations Waiver</u>
