

FFPSA Exceptions to 14-day limit on IV-E funding

The variations between North Carolina’s two different processing systems:

Item of Interest	CPPS Counties (89)	NCFAS Counties (11)
Funding for Extended Foster Care 18 to 21 clients	Counties need to remember to use an “E” beside the appropriate funding designation.	Clear case closure and with a new case file for the young adult.
Reimbursement limitation indicators	To accommodate partial month adjustments during the service month, ALL funding will switch to SFHF for non-exempt clients.	Financial tab and reports will reflect the ongoing placements, indicating the different funding categories based on the allowed days.
Exceptions under Adolescent Parenting - Facility	Facility status is classified at a state level and is updated by state staff.	Facility status is classified at a state level and is updated nightly in the system.
Exceptions under Adolescent Parenting – Client	After placement in the facility, updates will be made to the DSS-5094 form under Non-Family Placement Services, fields 68-71, to identify the client as receiving these specific services.	County will need to update case information, Removals & Placements tab, for the specific home, and add the “FFPSA Exception” for “Parenting Support for Prenatal/Postpartum” option.
Preliminary Reports	Clients with partial or no qualifying days for the period will be designated with a code and description indicating a switch in funding.	The client will be represented by individual lines indicating the allowed reimbursement for nights of care under each funding code.
New Reporting	Additional new reports will be created to document and reimbursement allowable IVE expenses. Reports will be designated as the PQA625 and PQA725 reports and will print after the period closing AND process with the next closing.	Not applicable
