This webinar will introduce the START Model, installation and implementation processes, and accompanying technical assistance. START is an evidence-based model designed to transform the system of care within and between child welfare agencies and SUD treatment providers with the broad goal of keeping children safely with their parents whenever possible while promoting parental recovery and capacity to care for their children.

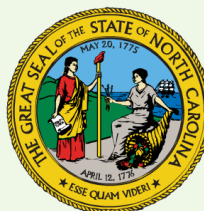
