

1 **10A NCAC 67A .0203 GOOD CAUSE FOR DELAYED HEARINGS**

2 (a) A state appeal hearing may be delayed for as much as 10 calendar days when there is good cause.

3 (b) Good cause exists when:

- 4 (1) There is a death in the appellant's family;
- 5 (2) The appellant or someone in his or her family is ill;
- 6 (3) The appellant is unable to obtain representation;
- 7 (4) The appellant's representative has a conflict with the scheduled date;
- 8 (5) The appellant receives a notice of action proposing a reduction or termination of assistance after the
9 10 work day notice expires;
- 10 (6) The appellant is unable to obtain transportation;
- 11 (7) The hearing officer determines that the hearing should be delayed for some other reason.
