Local Community Child Protection Teams (CCPT) play a vital role in assessing the child welfare system in NC and informing how well community services meet the needs of the children and families. The CCPT is an interdisciplinary group of community representatives who meet regularly to promote a community-wide approach to prevent child maltreatment.

The CCPT 2018 End of Year Survey and Report are part of a Continuous Quality Improvement (CQI) process that is mandated by the federal Child Abuse Prevention and Treatment Act (CAPTA). It will also inform the mandated CCPT report to county commissioners and DSS.
