

## Responding to Families and Communities Impacted by Meth

**Description:** *Responding to Families and Communities Impacted by Meth* is a one-day training designed to improve the ability of child welfare workers to respond when children are in settings where methamphetamine is being manufactured. This training will review the signs of methamphetamine use and production and will cover the protocol for the safety of workers and children. We will focus on the responsibilities of child welfare workers as part of the response team of community professionals including the use of a family-entered approach.

**Prerequisite:** Child Welfare in North Carolina or completion of other required pre-service training based on date of employment and functional responsibilities.

**Target Audience:** Child Welfare social workers and supervisors in a county Department of Social Services.

**Contact Hours:** Six contact hours. This training can be credited toward the required 24 hours continuing education component.
