

NOTICE TO THE HEAD OF FOOD AND NUTRITION SERVICES HOUSEHOLD

The issuance dates for Food and Nutrition Services EBT benefits are changing. Starting in July 2011, your household's Food and Nutrition Services benefits will still be placed in your EBT account based on the last number of your Social Security Number (SSN), but the issuance dates have changed. The new issuance schedule is:

If your SSN ends in:	Old date benefits available before July 2011	New date benefits will be available effective July 2011 after <u>6:00 a.m.</u>
1	3rd day of every month	3rd day of every month
2	4th day of every month	5th day of every month
3	5th day of every month	7th day of every month
4	6th day of every month	9th day of every month
5	7th day of every month	11th day of every month
6	8th day of every month	13th day of every month
7	9th day of every month	15th day of every month
8	10th day of every month	17th day of every month
9	11th day of every month	19th day of every month
0	12th day of every month	21st day of every month

For example, if your SSN is 234-56-7890, regular benefits will be placed in your EBT account on July 21st and, on the 21st of each month, your household is eligible to receive Food and Nutrition Services. If your SSN is 123-45-6789, regular benefits will be placed in your EBT account on July 19th and, on the 19th of each month, your household is eligible to receive Food and Nutrition Services.

If you don't have a SSN, your benefits will be placed in your EBT account on the 3rd calendar day of each month.
