Dear County Director of Social Services:

As a follow-up to the July 18th, Dear County Director Letter, we are sending out an update to the Wake location.

The Division of Social Services is pleased to announce that Work Support Strategies and NC FAST will be conducting ten (10) Operational Readiness Workshops across the state from July 23 through August 15, 2013.
