^{1/} The Agricultural Act of 2014 required FNS to adjust the FY 2014 tolerance level (of \$37) for excluding small errors by the percentage by which the Thrifty Food Plan (TFP) is adjusted for future years. FY 2015 is the first year the tolerance level is adjusted based on the TFP adjustment. As a result, the FY 2015 error tolerance level is \$38.
