- What the data DOES include:

 Every referral from an Emergency Department, regardless of whether the referral turned into an admission
- * Every leterial from all Enletgency Department, regardless or whether the reterial curried in a currission.

 Average hours waiting: from the time the ED placed the callifax to the state hospital to the time testate hospital called the ED to inform them a bed was available. The wait time is state hospital discovers the patient was sent elsewhere or taken off of the IVC (this is dependent upon the ED following through to inform the state that alternative arrangements were
- Referrals from every LME-MCO in North Carolina
- Referrals for every state hospital in North Carolina
- Referrals for all ages and service types

What the data DOES NOT include:
