

Combination Long Term Care Facilities are licensed as Skilled Nursing Facilities (often referred to as Nursing Homes) that also have Adult Care Home beds (which in NC include Assisted Living Beds) and may choose to follow the Skilled Nursing Facility rules, the Adult Care Home rules or a combination. These facilities may have Special Care Units for persons with Alzheimer's Disease or related dementias. These special care units are locked and secured.

Adult Care Homes (which in NC include Assisted Living Facilities) have a license that indicates that a special care unit for residents with Alzheimer's Disease or related disorders is provided. These facilities may advertise, market or otherwise promote themselves as having Special Care Units for persons with Alzheimer's Disease or related disorders (other types of dementia/cognitive impairment). These Special Care Units are locked and secure.
