



NCDHHS \$3 million Investment to Strengthen the Direct **Support Professionals Workforce** As part of its <u>Direct Support Professional Workforce Plan</u>, the NC Department of Health and Human Services is announcing \$3 million to recruit and retain direct support professionals

programs including a wage protection program, a recruitment campaign, implementing a new HR system, and two mentoring programs. A second round of DSP incentives will be made available in spring of 2025. These efforts aim to create a supportive workforce to help people with I/DD live and thrive in their communities.

Inclusion Works is well underway in conducting site visits and completing


(DSPs). DSPs assist people with I/DD in daily tasks
