










Section 1: CACFP workstation specifications: This contains the minimum recommended standards for utilizing the new CACFP application.

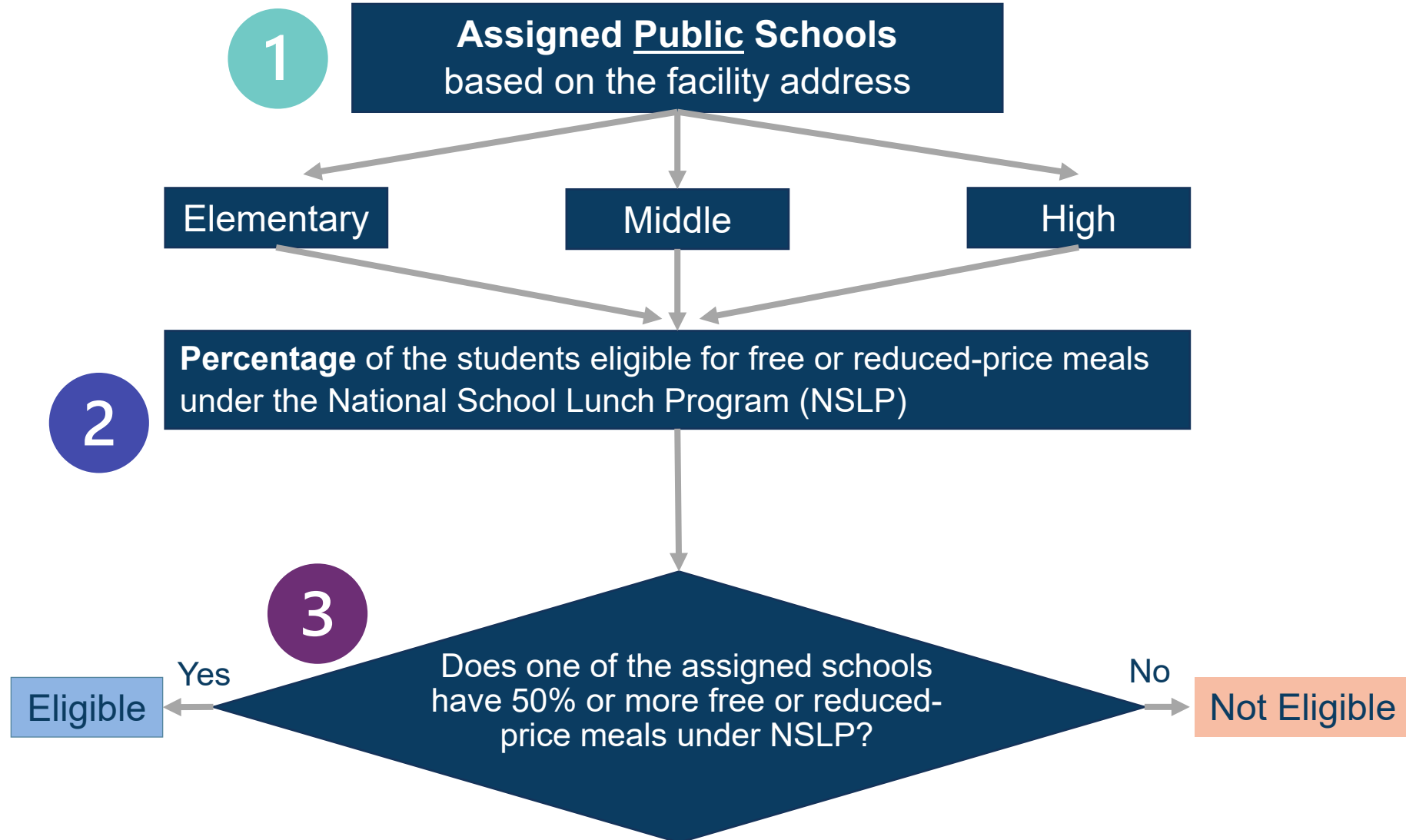
