



BECOMING A JYNNEOS PROVIDER

Thank you for your interest in becoming a Jynneos vaccine provider! Your willingness to support the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services goals of MPox readiness is greatly appreciated.

According to HHS, to become approved and administer the Jynneos vaccine, you must be trained and supervised by a medical provider.

Step 1

Take the NCDHHS Mpox Vaccine Enrollment and Capacity Survey.

Step 2

Upon completing the survey, NCDHHS will review the information and notify you of approval.

Step 3

Once approved, you can request JYNNEOS or transfers, and manage your inventory, in NCIR. For more information on requesting doses, click here.

What is NCIR?

The North Carolina Immunization Registry (NCIR) is a secure, web-based clinical tool which is the official source for North Carolina immunization information.

Immunization providers may access all recorded immunizations administered in North Carolina, regardless of where the immunizations were given.

The purpose of NCIR is:

- To give patients, parents, health care providers, schools, and childcare facilities timely access to complete, accurate, and relevant immunization data;
- To assist in the evaluation of a child's immunization status and identify children who need (or are past due for) immunizations; and
- To assist communities in assessing their immunization coverage and identifying areas of under-immunization.
