

Paths to CIE Guide Frequently Asked Questions

Who is this guide for?

This guide is to support care providers and guardians supporting individuals with I/DD who are interested in possible pursuing a job in a <u>competitive integrated employment setting</u>.

What is Competitive Integrated Employment (CIE)?

Competitive Integrated Employment (CIE) means:

- Working in the community alongside other employees without disabilities.
- Earning at least minimum wage.
- Getting the same workplace benefits and opportunities as other employees doing the same job.

What does this guide tell me?

This guide will provide key information and a step-by-step process to reaching competitive integrated employment. It will explain the support services that are available to individuals with I/DD and how to access them.

Can individuals with I/DD navigate this guide on their own?

This version of the guide is recommended for people supporting individuals with I/DD, including their care managers, providers, and families. We encourage you to complete this tool with the individuals you are supporting.

NCDHHS is planning to develop another version of this guide that is more suitable for use by individuals with I/DD.
