- A developmental disability:
  - Is chronic
  - Begins at birth or during childhood
  - Adversely affects an individual's daily living and functioning
- Developmental disabilities can be caused by a mental impairment, a physical impairment or combination of both mental and physical.






- CIE Means:


- A meaningful day is a result of a day filled with planned and purposeful activities.

- Meaningful day activities can be used along with parttime employment to fill each week.





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
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
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
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
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
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
