- A developmental disability:
  - Is chronic
  - Begins at birth or during childhood
  - Adversely affects an individual's daily living and functioning
- Developmental disabilities can be caused by a mental impairment, a physical impairment or combination of both mental and physical.

## Competitive Integrated Employment

- CIE Means:
  - Working in the community alongside other employees without disabilities.
  - Earning at least minimum wage.
  - Getting the same workplace benefits and opportunities as other employees doing the same job.
- Working in CIE is a great way to connect with others, boost confidence, build skills, increase stability, and improve overall health.
- Working and earning money opens doors to new things, such as living in your own place, having more choices about how to spend your free time, and having other opportunities that can positively impact your life.

- Switching providers while keeping the same or similar services is possible, parts of this guide about switching providers explains further



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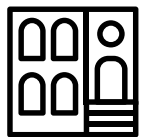
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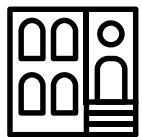
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# Definitions – Informed Choice

## Informed Choice

- As individuals with I/DD consider their employment options, questions often arise:
  - Does the person want to work in Competitive Integrated Employment?
  - What kind of a job do they want?
  - What are their career interests?
  - And who is really making the decision: Is it the individual, or others on their behalf?
- Informed Choice is the process of choosing from options based on accurate information, knowledge, and experiences.
  - Choosing to pursue CIE is one possible outcome.
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# Definitions – LME/MCO

## Local Management Entity/Managed Care Organization

- An LME/MCO coordinates services for I/DD individuals, connecting with Providers who help deliver services.
- There are four LME/MCOs that serve the State of North Carolina, and each are responsible for a set of counties.

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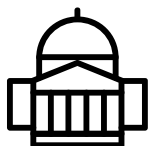
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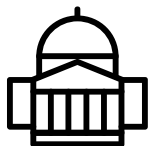
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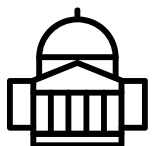
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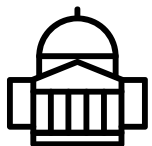
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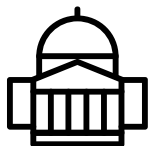
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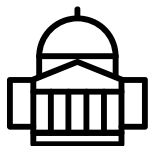




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## Tailored Care Manager (TCM)

- A Tailored Care Manager is an individual assigned to you to provide Tailored Care Management, a new type of care management that began December 1, 2022, for eligible NC Medicaid beneficiaries.
- Your TCM can help guide you through many steps of the process covered in this guide.

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# Definitions – Meaningful Week

## Meaningful Week

- A meaningful day is a result of a day filled with planned and purposeful activities.
  - Meaningful days make meaningful weeks.
- Services supporting meaningful day allow stability, space, and resources that help develop skills.
  - The skills gained in meaningful day services can result in more success in CIE.
- Meaningful day activities can be used along with part-time employment to fill each week.
