	<p>Answer: The costs associated with moving complex statewide outcomes to clearly measurable statewide impacts will be the largest determinate for the applicant organization’s funding level request. Award Amount and Term <ul style="list-style-type: none"> An Applicant organization may submit no more than one application in <u>each</u> category - Does this mean that organizations can submit one application in each budget category (\$500K - \$3M, \$75K - \$500K, \$75K and below)?
	<p>Answer: Yes. An eligible applicant organization may submit no more than one application in each category.</p>
3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Question: On the NPRFA Competitive Grant Process Budget Form - All budget lines are for two year total of grant period, not an annual grant request, correct?
	<p>Answer: Yes, depending on the time frame of the applicant organization’s project. One or two years. The Proposal Budget Template for NPRFA Awards is for 2021-2023. Successful 2021-2023 NPRFA awards will be required to negotiate final budgets with DHHS and all final award amounts for this grant program are subject to funds availability and legislative priorities.</p>

Any tribal government, community-based, public, or private nonprofit, tax-exempt organization (including faith-based), school system or local government agency that is duly incorporated and registered under North Carolina Statutes is eligible to apply.</i></p> <p><i>All eligible organizations’ applications must clearly document how its application closely aligns with the DHHS Strategic Plan discussed in III - General Instructions and Format, Item C – Alignment with DHHS Strategic Plan. The DHHS Strategic Plan begins on page 37.</i></p>
