Successful 2021-2023 NPRFA awards will be required to negotiate final budgets with DHHS and all final award amounts for this grant program are subject to funds availability and legislative priorities.

Answer:

See General Information - Item C: Eligibility. Any tribal government, community-based, public, or private nonprofit, tax-exempt organization (including faith-based), school system or local government agency that is duly incorporated and registered under North Carolina Statutes is eligible to apply.
